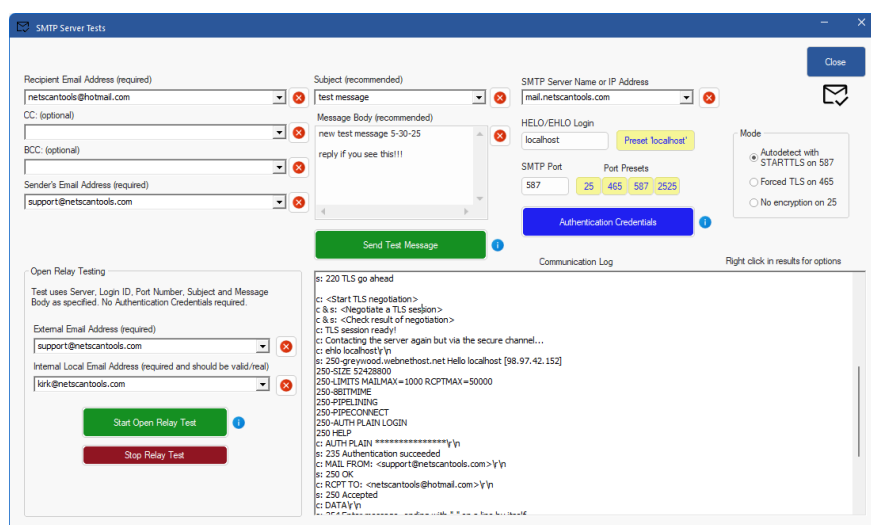
Upcoming Release NST Pro Version 11.95

We are set to release the 11.95 upgrade in the coming weeks. Here are some key changes you can expect from the latest version:

- Export Options highlighted in SSL Scanner

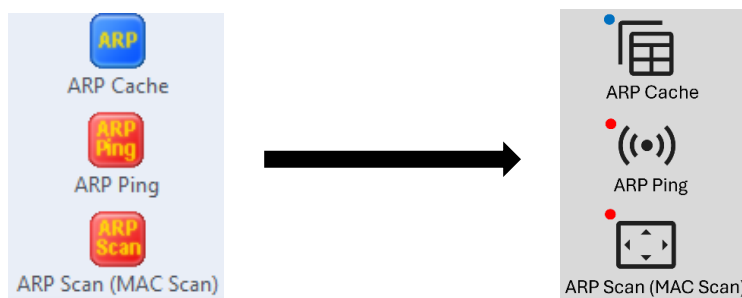
New SMTP Server Tests tool

- The updated tool now fully supports **STARTTLS**, ensuring encrypted connections. It provides **comprehensive logging** of all communication between the client and mail server, giving you full visibility into the session. Additionally, it features **four distinct open relay tests**, offering robust security validation.



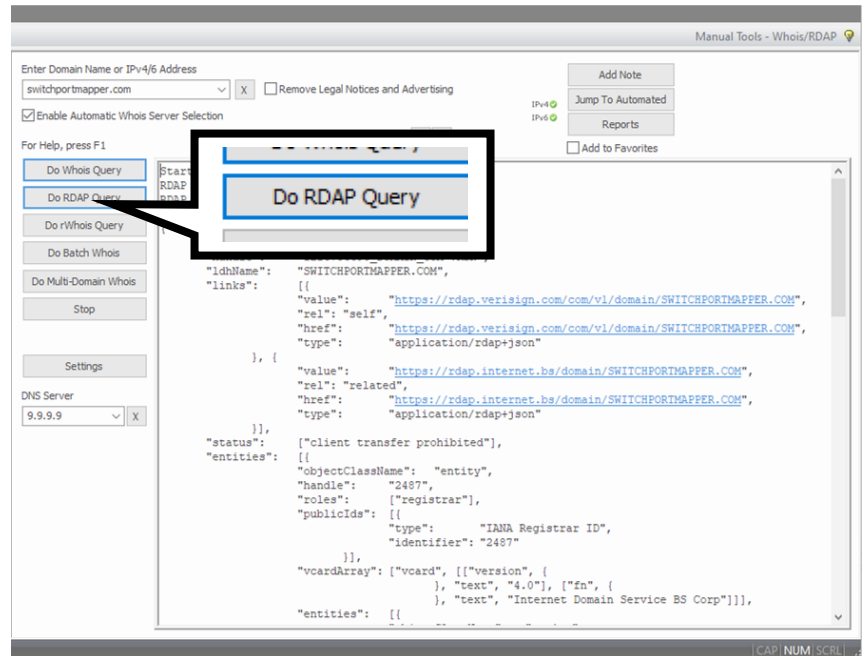
Updated Tool Icons

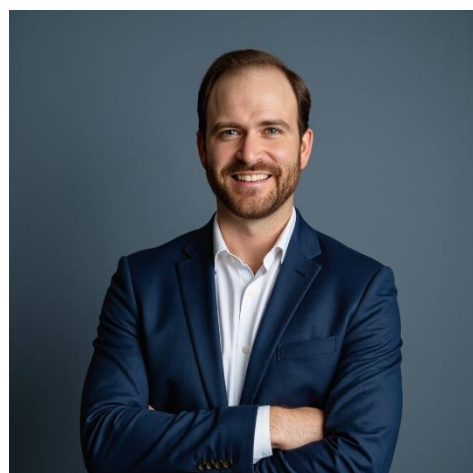


New Additions to Our Leadership Team

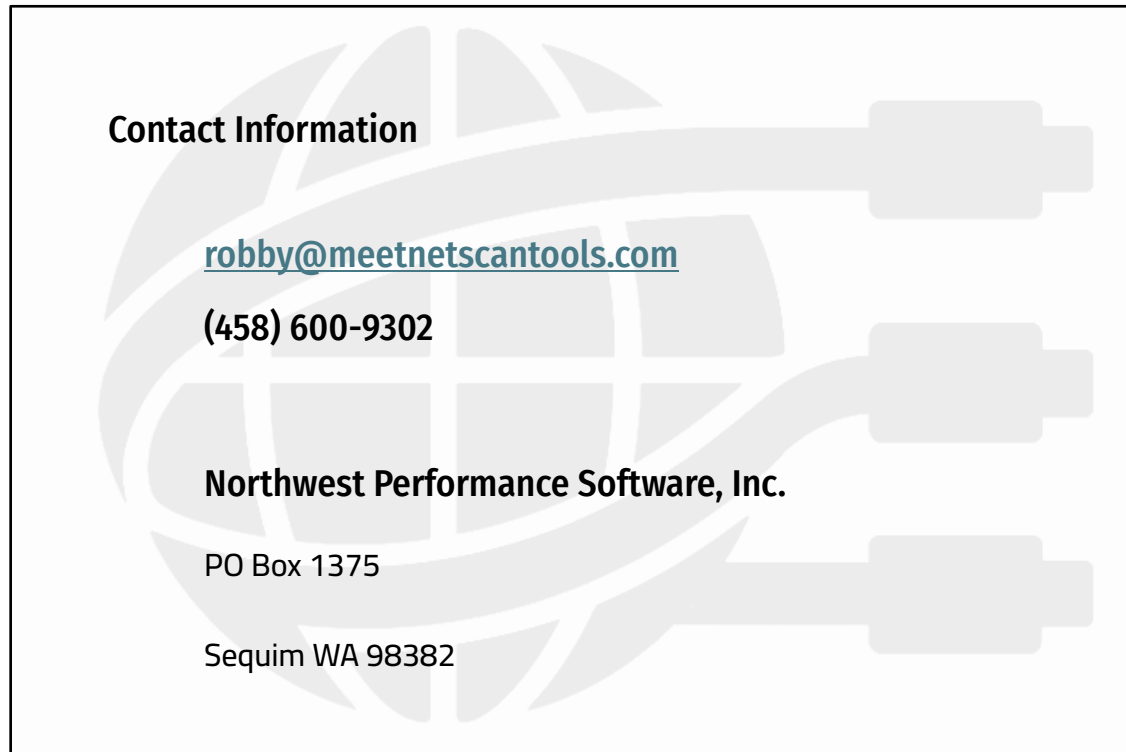
