Switch Port Mapper Update Version 2.88

Highlights:

- Fixed database export issue where SQL reserved characters could trigger an exception during export.
- Removed the toolbar that appeared below the menus.
- SNMP Walk Tool now correctly identifies and shows the source of errors — making troubleshooting faster and clearer.
- Manual “Check for Update” now offers a direct link to the download page when an update is available.
- PDF manual now included for easy offline access.
- Updated SQLite to version 3.50.4.
- Updated MAC address/Manufacturer database.



- Added Extended Validation (EV) certificate to reduce Windows SmartScreen warnings and improve installer trust.
