



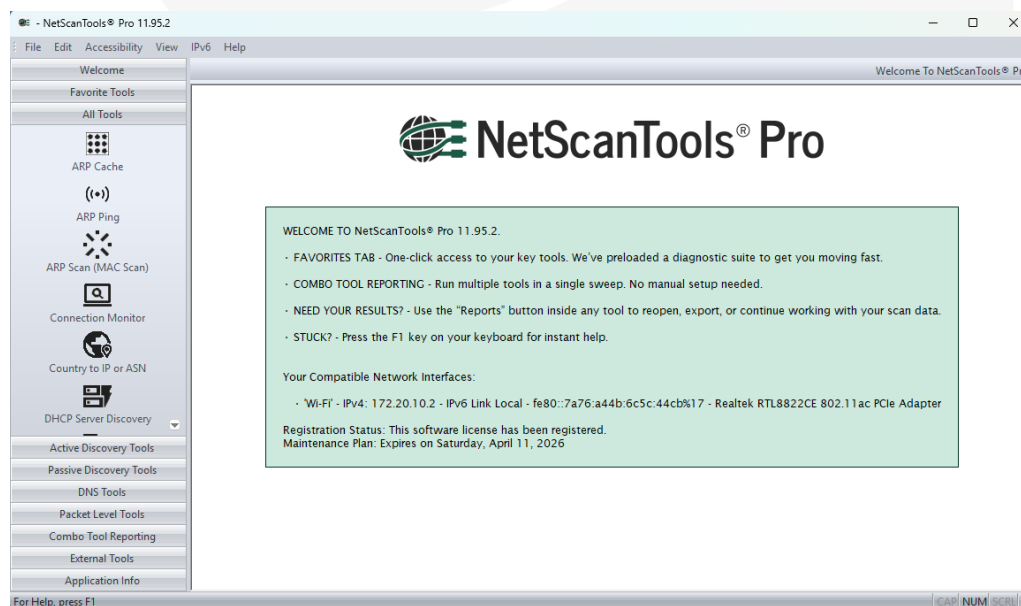

NetScanTools Pro v11.95.2 Available Now

The latest release includes layout improvements, UI refinements, and data updates. Here's what's new in **v11.95.2 (August 15, 2025)**:



Interface & Navigation Updates

- **New Logo + Welcome Banner**

The Welcome screen now features updated branding and refreshed layout text.

- **Left Panel Reorganized**

- Automated Tools has been renamed to Combo Tools Reporting and moved down the menu to prioritize favorites.
- Favorites Group moved up — now directly under Welcome.
- New: **Start with Favorites** button added to the Welcome group.
- Favorites are now **pre-populated with common tools** to help new users get started faster.
- Manual Tools renamed to **All Tools**.

- **Check for Updates / Social Media**

These have moved to the Application Info group.

Reporting Enhancements

- **Improved Browser Reports**

“View in Web Browser” reports now display the new logo and improved color formatting for easier reading and printing.

Tool Changes



- **Traceroute (TCP mode)**

Now defaults to port 443 (HTTPS) instead of 80 (HTTP) — better compatibility with modern firewall rules.

- **Subnet Calculator**

Layout improvements for better clarity

- **DNS & Text Results Tools**

Several tools now auto-scroll to the top when results complete, including:

- IPv4 Drilldown
- SPF/DMARC/DKIM
- VOIP SRV Records
- Misc SRV Records
- WhoAmI
- Simple Query
- Common Records

Database Updates

- **SQLite engine updated** to v3.50.4
- Refreshed **MAC address/vendor database**
- Updated **IP-to-Country database**

Built for larger or distributed teams that value portability, live training, and extended updates. Includes USB and desktop editions of both the Pro and the Switch Port Mapping Tool full guided onboarding, and two-year maintenance plans.

Sold In Three Quantities

Single License – perfect for individual users

4-Pack – designed for small teams

10-Pack – ideal for medium-sized groups

Feature Highlight Reporting Function

NetScanTools Pro automatically records the results of every test into a searchable, exportable database. It's a built-in reporting system that doesn't require extra setup — just run your tools, and the data is stored.

Here's what it offers:

Key Features

- **Searchable History:** tests are logged with time, target, and tool used.
- **Filter & Export:** Filter by target or reference number, then export to plain text.
- **Analyst Info (Optional):** Include your name and contact, or keep reports anonymous.
- **MD5 Hash Check:** Each result has a checksum to verify data integrity.
- **Right-Click Options:** Open reports, copy reference numbers, or export directly from the list.



Use Cases

- Retrieve past scans quickly.
 - Include test data in documentation or audit reports.
 - Maintain consistent historical records.
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How To Access It

After running a test, click the Reports button in the upper-right corner of the tool window.

This takes you straight to the history view for all tests, across all tools.

It runs quietly in the background — but it's one of the most useful parts of the software when you need it.
