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Switchport Mapping Tool 2.90 Now Available

Switch Port Mapper 2.90 is now available, bringing several improvements to switch data processing and device compatibility.

This release includes a significant rewrite of how **Interface Speed** data is processed to accommodate reporting changes introduced in **Cisco IOS 17.12.03 and newer**. We've also improved the processing of **Interface Description, Alias, Name, and Type** data to provide more reliable information when mapping switch ports.

Version 2.90 also improves ARP query handling by recognizing when a configured server/router IP matches the switch itself and automatically skipping the redundant query. Rounding out the release are an updated **MAC address/manufacture database**, an update to **SQLite 3.53.4**, and several smaller maintenance changes.

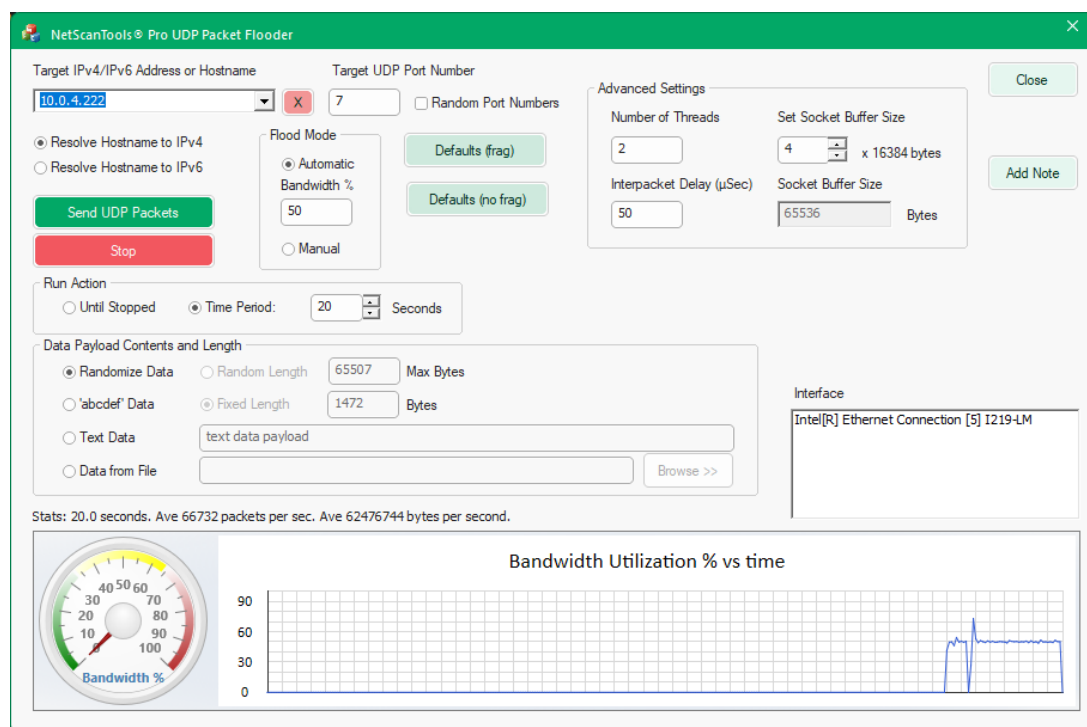
NST Pro V12 Progress update

Development of **NetScanTools Pro v12** is continuing to make steady progress, and we have another round of previews to share from the upcoming release. Below, you'll find a look at several completed tools featuring the refreshed interface and improvements coming in v12.

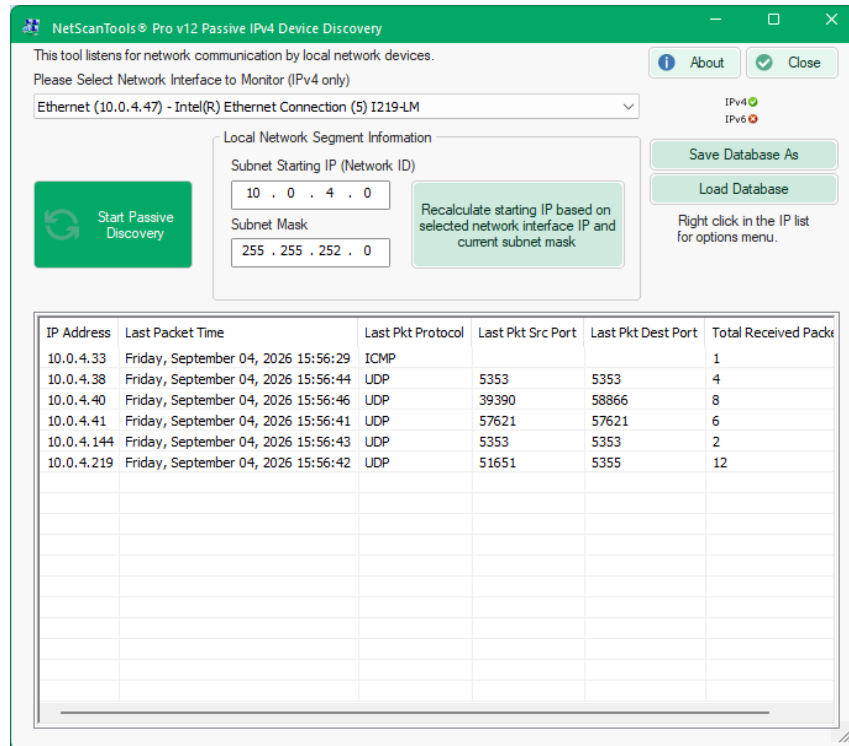
A major focus of Version 12 is making it quicker and easier to navigate the growing collection of tools in NetScanTools Pro. The new **searchable, topic-based navigation pane** groups tools by function and lets you search by tool name, keyword, or related tag—helping you get to the tool you need without having to remember exactly where it lives.

Along with the updated navigation, we're continuing to refine the interface and individual tools throughout the application. We'll keep sharing more of what's new as v12 gets closer to release.

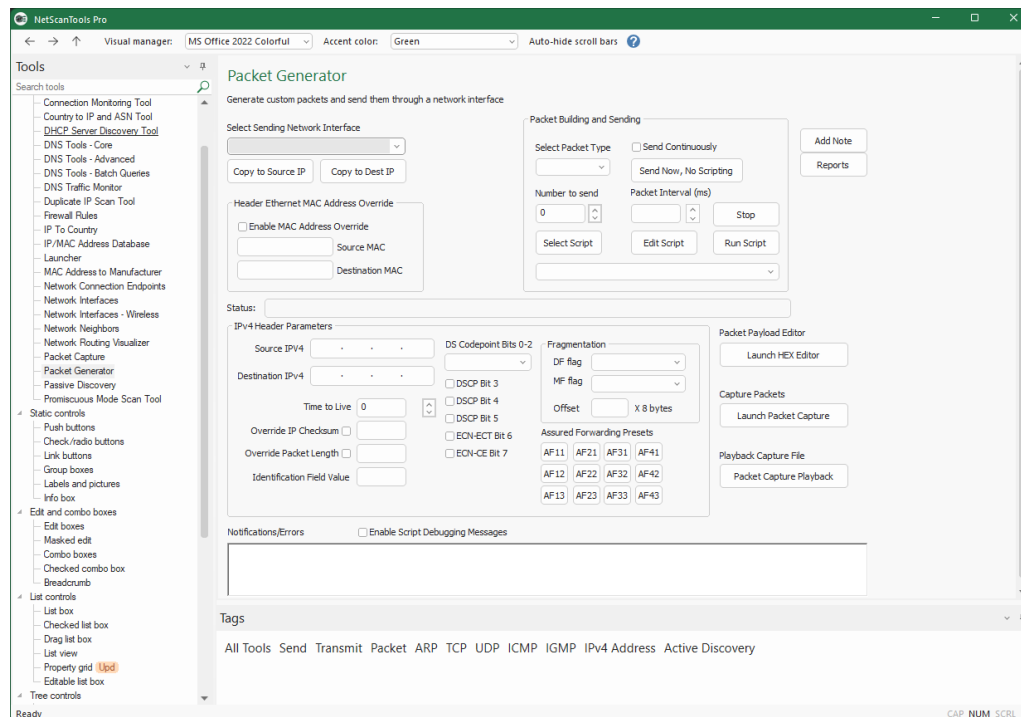
Packet Flooder:
